Some of the main next steps for EWS identified during 3rd workshop

- * Develop a database of existing EWS in the region
- * Create key messages to be sent by RDS for any kind of hazard
- * Advocate for widespread of CAP and RDS
- * Ensure continuous training of people who received RDS receivers
- * Organize regular testing
- * Reinforce local monitoring and warning methods
- * ...

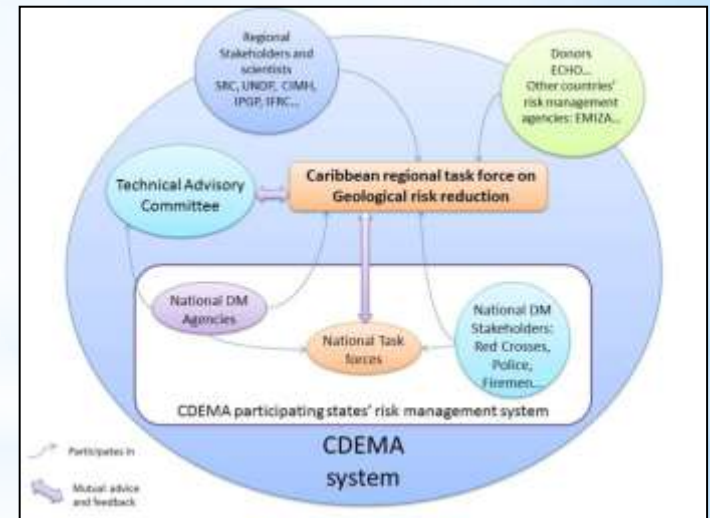
